Dear Parents/Guardians,

On Thursday 4th May both schools will be closed to all pupils, except Y6, due to being used as a polling station. Little Dragons' Pre-school will be open as usual. On this day, our Y6 pupils will be working with staff to have SATs booster sessions and some staff will be having training. We have also been notified that due to the general election we will also be used as a polling station in June.

This is a busy time of year for our Y6 pupils and of course our Y6 staff who are working hard to fully prepare the children for their tests and I would like to take this opportunity to thank them for all their hard work.

This week we have had our first meeting of Trustees since we became a MAT. The MAT has a different governance model which consists of a board of five 'members' who meet once a year, a board of Trustees who meet at least half termly and each school has a Local Governing Body which will meet termly. As I am sure you are aware, nominations for Parent Governors are currently being sought for this role.

Both our schools are currently involved in a research project looking at marking and feedback. A number of classes will be piloting a new approach to marking and we will keep parents informed of any changes in due course. The Department of Education is interested in publishing the outcomes of this project and this is a great accolade for our MAT. As part of our research, this week I have worked with senior leaders in each school to conduct a workbook scrutiny and was delighted with the high standard of pupil progress in books.
