We have received our KS2 SATs results this week and we are over the moon for the Y6 children. The children have taken their results home now to share with their families.

Our results showed:

80% expected or above in Reading

80% expected or above in writing

80% expected or above in Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar

66% expected or above in Maths

With a combined scores of pupils receiving Expected in Reading, Writing and Maths of 61%.

I am so proud of the children for trying so hard and with such resilience. I would also like to thank the staff for all their hard work too.
