If the watch becomes a distraction to the child then, as with any other item, it would be confiscated, returned at the end of the day and the child would be asked not to bring it into school again. Can we also remind parents that dogs (unless guide dogs) are not to be brought onto the premises at any time. Children have been asked to dismount from bikes, skateboards and scooters at the school gate and we would like any parents who travel on bikes to do the same please. As always, parents are not to use the car park for dropping off or collecting children at any time unless they are blue badge holders and are parking in the disabled bay.
